



1. Fields

1.1 CBSA Code (mbr_cbsa): Core Based Statistical Area (CBSA) code; a CBSA is a U.S. geographic region determined by the Office of Management and Budget.

1.2 CBSA Title (mbr_cbsa_title): Name(s) of the main urban area(s) in each CBSA.

1.3 Theme (theme): Factors in the Minority Health SVI are categorized into six themes and a composite measure:

1.3.4 Minority Status and Language

1.3.5 Housing Type and Transportation

2. Metrics

2.1 Minority Health SVI Value (value): For each index, the reported SVI is the percentile rank representing a community's vulnerability. Values range from 0 (indicating a less vulnerable community) to 1 (indicating a more vulnerable community). Each SVI value is aggregated to the CBSA-level using a weight that represents the share of the population in each county.

2.2 County Count (county_count): The number of counties in each CBSA.

2.3 Estimated Total Population (e_totpop): For each CBSA, the estimated total population, derived from the American Community Survey and reported from the CDC's Minority Health SVI public database, summed across all counties in a CBSA.

2.4 ESI Share (esi_share): The proportion of the population in a CBSA with employer-sponsored insurance.
